

**Former President of the Central Council of Jews in Germany

- Born October 29, 1932 in Munich as daughter of Fritz Neuland
- survived the Holocaust in hiding in a peasants' family
- returned in 1945 to Munich (camp for displaced persons)
- 1951 wedding with Samuel Knobloch (3 children, 7 grandchildren)
- since 1982 managing committee of the Jewish Community and Upper Bavaria
- since 1985 President of the Jewish Community in Munich and Upper Bavaria
- 1997-2006 Vice-President of the Central Council of Jews in Germany
- 2003-2010 Vice-President of the European Jewish Congress
- since 2005 Vice-President of the World Jewish Congress
- since 2005 honorary citizen of her hometown Munich
- 2006 till 2010 President of the Central Council of Jews in Germany
- since 2008 Bearer of the Great Cross of Merit of the Federal Republic of Germany
- since 2009 honorary doctorate from the University Tel-Aviv
- 2010 awarded with the Großen Verdienstkreuz mit Stern des Verdienstordens der Bundesrepublik Deutschland
